Registration Fees

U13 – U19 - \$1600 Returning Player	\$1650 New Player (No additional fees)
U11 – U12 - \$850 Returning Player	\$900 New Player (Tournament fees are additional)
U07 – U10 - \$650 Returning Player	\$700 New Player (Tournament fees are additional)

Tournament Entry Fees will be handled as Follows:

U13 – U19: \$400 of each player's Registration Fee is allocated for team tournament fees. Each team will be evaluated in March to determine if a subsidy will be assessed for un-budgeted tournament expenses.

U9 – U12: Tournament entry fees are separate from the Registration Fee and will be split evenly among each player and collected on a per tournament basis. Players will get billed for tournaments their team is playing regardless of injury or sickness.

Teams will attend a number of tournaments during the season. All Players are expected to participate in each tournament that their team is competing in.

The Registration Fee covers all of the expenses for the season with the exception of U12's and below tournament fees as defined above. There are no additional monthly fees.

- Training Fees for Year (no additional monthly fees)
- Uniforms (game and practice)
- Coaches travel expenses
- Equipment (balls, nets, training equipment etc.)
- Goalie Training
- Association fees (FYSA, USA, CDL, USCS etc.)
- League Referee fees
- Facility expenses (field rental, maintenance, lights etc.)

Payment – Registration fees can be broken down into monthly payments. All players are required to pay their entire Registration Fee. Players who are behind in their payments may be held from participation with team unless there is a pre-arranged payment plan in place. If payment plan is not being followed then player can be withheld from further participation with the club until payments are brought up to date. There will be a service charge of \$10.00 on payment plan per month.

Upon completion of Gotsoccer Registration and initial payment or deposit, player is then committed to the club for the entire season and is expected to fulfill financial commitment. If a player chooses to leave the club before the end of the commitment time (Memorial Day weekend 2018), he/she will not be released until paid in full. There are no transfer fees. Fees can be paid by E-check or credit card. SSFC is a 5013c non-profit organization and any portion of your fees can be paid through a Sponsor. Special payment processing and requests can be arranged with approval from the club.

Practice/Training: Younger teams 12 and under will practice and train at least twice a week. There could be an additional day if preparing for an upcoming tournament. Older teams practice three times a week during peak playing times. Players are expected to attend all practice and training sessions. Individual training is offered for an additional fee at certain times for those that are interested.

Travel: Parents are responsible for their travel expenses. Some tournaments require hotel bookings to be made through their Travel Agency and all participants will be required to stay in the designated hotel.

Regular Season – All teams will participate in the Club Directors League (CDL) for regular season league. U15 – U19 will be August through October then February & March. U9 – U12 will be October through May.

Guest Playing: SSFC players may guest play in tournaments for teams from clubs that allow their players to guest play for other clubs. All requests must be approved by the director of coaching.

Optional Apparel: Several times throughout the season SSFC apparel will be available for purchase. **These items are all optional.** Items include team bags, warm-ups, extra practice uniforms, T-shirts, polo shirts, sweatshirts, etc.

Fundraisers: SSFC will hold one major fundraiser. Each player will be responsible for two (2) tickets at \$50.00 per ticket. Tickets not purchased will be charged to player accounts. Individual teams may organize any additional fundraisers on their own.
